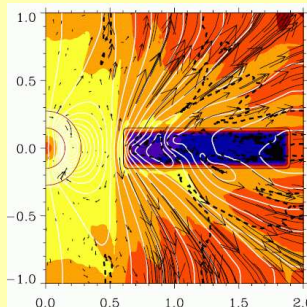
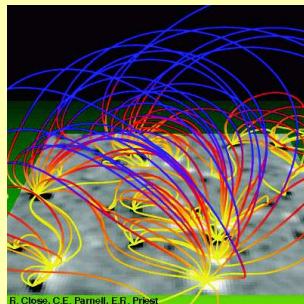
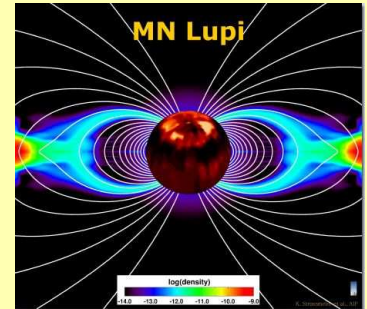
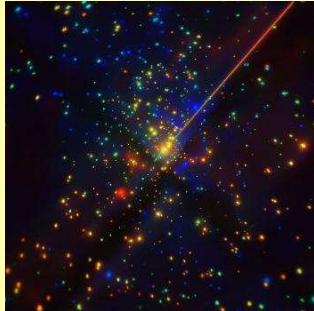
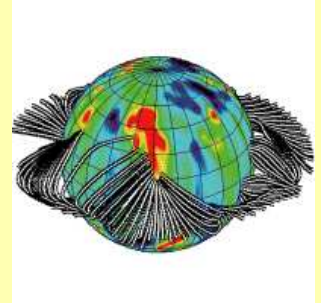
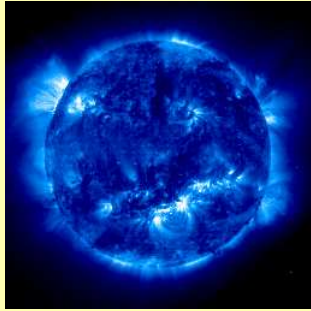
12 – 13 December 2006
